- Notable pedestrian demand across Cockle Bay Road-Pah Road predominantly during the morning and evening peaks.
- A high percentage of the pedestrians observed were dog-walkers and recreational pedestrians to and from the beach.

- Vehicle speeds along Cockle Bay Road-Pah Road are higher than posted speed limit, particularly southbound.
- No issues were observed for vehicles turning into and out of Churchill Road and/or Shelly Beach Parade.
- Visibility from the two intersections was considered satisfactory.

Crash data



- Crash record review for 2020 to November 2025 shows 2 crashes have occurred at the intersection in the past 5+ years.
- No specific crash trends were noted.
