## ON A SINGLE SECTION NEXT TO YOU?

Recent changes in legislation means Auckland Council is required to change its planning rules.

Auckland Council must:

- Enable greater housing density (6 storeys or more) within walkable distances of the city centre; metropolitan centres and rapid transit stops. Also amend building heights and densities around neighbourhood and local town centres.
- Introduce Medium Density Residential Standards that allow up to 3 homes of up to 3 storeys to be built on most residential sites without a resource consent. This will include many areas currently zoned for single houses only.
- Replace design rules for developments including height to boundary ratios and outdoor space requirements.

Council is asking for feedback on their proposals to be provided **by Monday 9 May 2022**. Later, there will be a chance to make submissions on a publicly notified plan change.
